Program: Hetch Hetchy Water Power (HHWP) Water Enterprise Program

Contract No. HH-925, Award Three-Year Hetch Hetchy As-Needed Paving Contract

Recommendation:	Approve the plans and specifications and award HHWP Water Enterprise Program-funded Contract No. HH-925, Three-Year Hetch Hetchy As-Needed Paving Contract, in the amount of \$2,274,200 to the lowest, qualified, responsible and responsive bidder, Delta Construction to reconstruct the Hetch Hetchy roadways.
Background:	Hetch Hetchy Water and Power owns and maintains roadways in Stanislaus County and Tuolumne County along the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission rights-of-way to access their various facilities. These roadways are heavily distressed and experience excessive amount of cracking because of several years of usage in addition to the normal wear and tear. Failure to maintain and repair these roadways will result in loss of accessibility to the facilities.

Description:	Contract work location(s) are in San Francisco Public Utilities Commission rights-of-way from Tesla Portal in Tracy, California to the O'Shaughnessy and/or Eleanor Dam in Tuolumne, California. The contract work consists of reconstructing the Hetch Hetchy roadways by placing 6" thick Class II aggregate base with or without 2" AC resurfacing, overlaying with 2" thick AC, or placing chip seal and any other required appurtenant and incidental work as described in the contract documents.

RESOLUTION NO. 09-0050

WHEREAS, Contract No. HH-925, Three-Year Hetch Hetchy As-Needed Paving Contract was advertised on November 19, 2008; and

WHEREAS, The baseline budget amount is \$2,780,725 and the Engineer's Estimate is \$2,780,725, for this construction contract work to maintain HHWP roadways; and

WHEREAS, The contract duration is one thousand sixty eight (1068) consecutive calendar days; and

WHEREAS, The Commission authorizes award of this Construction Contract for work to be performed under future task orders which will identify the scope of work, cost and duration of various discrete construction activities. No task order will be issued for construction requiring environmental review, excluding those eligible for statutory or categorical exemptions, until the Commission has been given the opportunity to review the environmental document and take action if deemed appropriate. The work under this construction contract has been competitively bid per unit price and this contractor is the lowest responsible, responsive bidder for the work under these subsequent task orders; and

WHEREAS, Four (4) bids were received and opened publicly on January 8, 2009; and

WHEREAS, SFPUC staff and HRC review of the bids for qualifications, responsibility, responsiveness and application of bid preferences resulted in the establishment of Delta Construction as the lowest, qualified, responsible and responsive bidder; and

WHEREAS, HRC waived LBE subcontracting goals for the project; and

WHEREAS, The firm being awarded a contract by the SFPUC must be in compliance with the Equal Benefits Provisions of Chapter 12B of the City's Administrative Code either at the time of the award, or within 2 weeks of the date of the Commission award; failure of the bidder to obtain compliance certification from HRC may result in award of the contract to the next lowest, responsible and responsive bidder, or re-bidding of the contract at the discretion of the City; and

WHEREAS, Failure to reach successful agreement on contract terms and conditions within 60 days of the date of the Commission award may result in award of the contract to the next lowest, responsible and responsive bidder, or re-bidding of the contract at the discretion of the City; and

WHEREAS, Funds are available from Project No. CUH-804 – Hetch Hetchy Roads Rebuilding, and Project No. CUH-977 – Facilities Maintenance; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Commission hereby approves the plans and specifications and awards Hetch Hetchy Water Enterprise Program-funded Contract No. HH-925, Three-Year Hetch Hetchy As-Needed Paving Contract, in the amount of \$2,274,200, to the lowest, qualified, responsible and responsive bidder, Delta Construction.
