

## Water Pipeline Construction Continues on Crystal Springs Road in Hillsborough

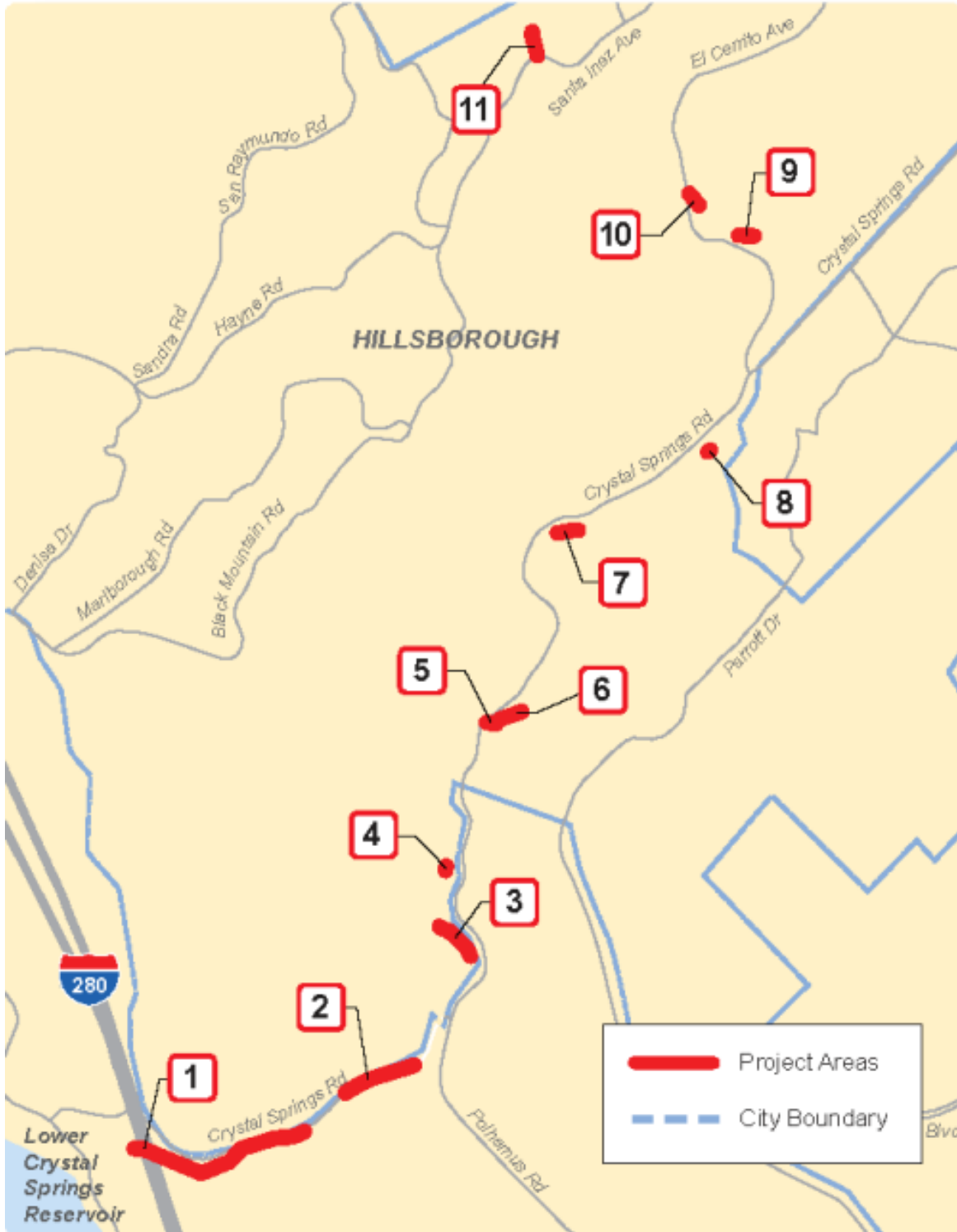

### Construction Activities:

Ranger Pipelines, Inc. will continue construction in your area to replace the regional water delivery pipeline known as Crystal Springs Pipeline No. 2 (CSPL2). Much of this work will be located along **Crystal Springs Road**. On the map, these are **project areas 2 through 8, and 10**.

## 5-DAY ROAD CLOSURE: Crystal Springs Road at Polhemus

Starting **Monday, September 17, Crystal Springs Road** from Polhemus Road to Skyline Blvd. (Highway 35), **will be closed for construction work.** The road closure will be in effect through **Friday, September 21.** Cyclists will have thru access to Crystal Springs Road during the road closure.

This short-term road closure is necessary to expedite construction, and will ensure the safety of the residents, and motorists who use this roadway.

Please note the **Black Mountain Road exit is the only way to reach the southern trailhead of Sawyer Camp Trail** from Hwy 280 during the five-day road closure.

**The road closure is for 5 consecutive days, 24 hours a day, during this critical construction phase.**

The SFPUC appreciates your patience and understanding during the construction of this important regional project.

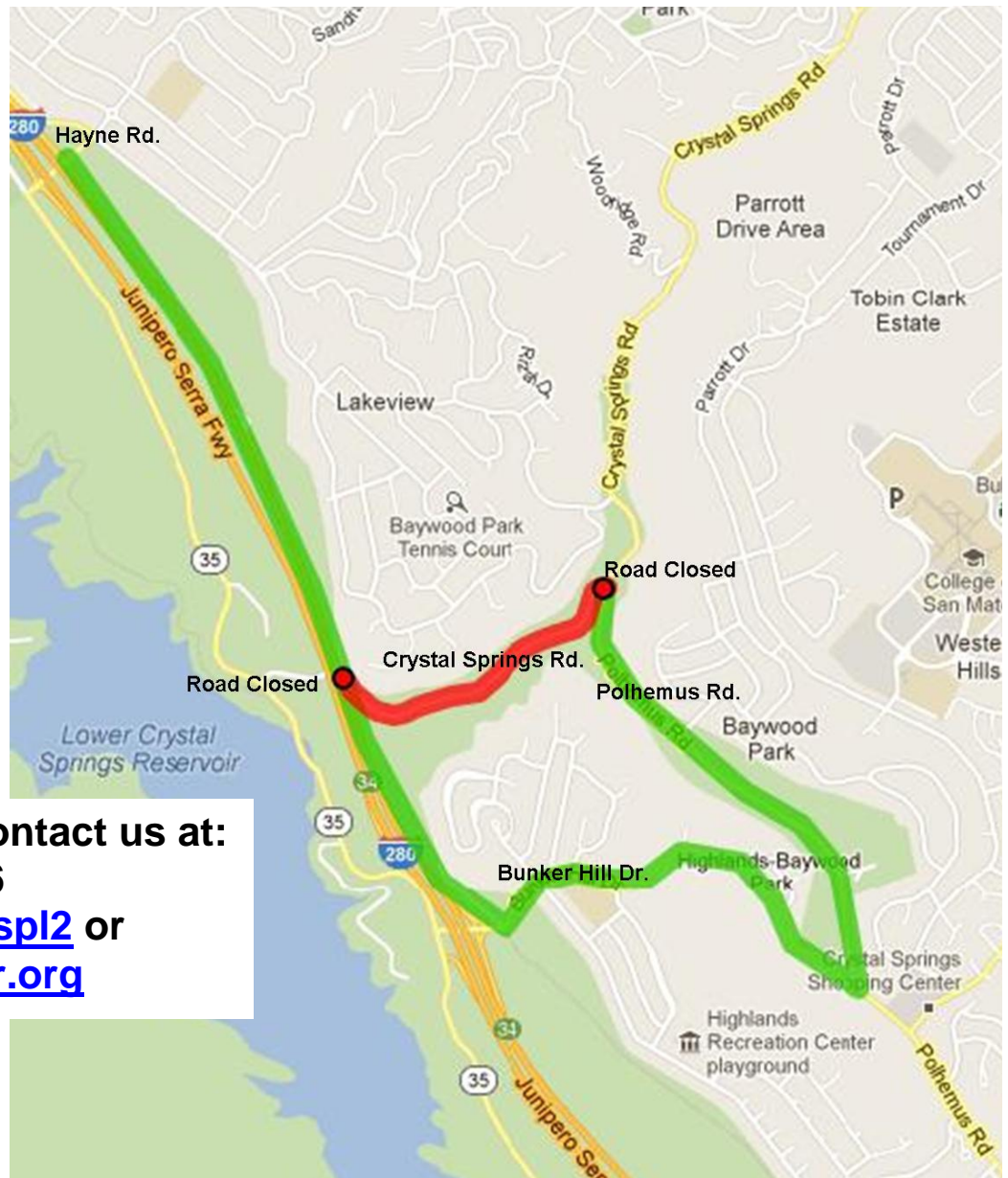
### Motorist Detour Information

#### **From 280:**

- Use 280 South to Bunker Hill Dr.
- Exit Bunker Hill Dr., continue East to Polhemus Road
- Turn left on Polhemus Road

#### **From Polhemus Road:**

- Go South on Polhemus Road
- Turn right (West) on Bunker Hill Dr.
- Take 280 North to Hayne/Black Mountain Exit
